# Soroptimist Violet Richardson Award Application

### **Instructions:**

### **Deadline: December 15th**

Completed applications and any supporting materials must be received by the above date, at the address listed in Step 3. Soroptimists, Soroptimist employees and the immediate families of both are ineligible, as are previous Violet Richardson Award winners.

### Step 1: Determine if you are eligible

Eligible applicants are young women who:

- are currently between the ages of 14 and 18
- have demonstrated initiative in both identifying a problem and trying to solve it
- have had significant and noteworthy accomplishments as volunteers **especially projects that benefit women and girls.**

### **Step 2: Complete the application**

To type on a writable PDF:

- First save the writable PDF file onto your computer. (If you immediately begin filling out the writable PDF file without having saved it onto your computer, your information will not save.)
- Once all parts of the form are personalized, select Save As from the File menu to save the document.
- Print and sign and mail the form to the following:

Share your role within the organization. What leadership responsibilities or duties do you have? If applicable, explain how you have taken initiative or gone beyond what was expected of you.

### 3. Choosing the Organization:

Explain how you selected the organization you are volunteering with. Did you join an existing group, or did you create your own to address a specific need?

### 4. Community Need and Organizational Response:

Identify the need you saw in your community. How does the organization you're involved with (or created) work to meet that need?

### 5. Successes and Accomplishments:

Include any accomplishments, milestones, or success stories related to your volunteer experience.

### 6. Being a Role Model:

Reflect on how you serve as a role model for other girls interested in volunteering or giving back to their communities.

**Tip:** Use clear examples and thoughtful reflection to demonstrate your impact, leadership, and commitment. Make sure your essay is well-organized and stays within the word count.
